SUBJECT: Multi-way Stop Investigation – N. Front St./W. Lockhart St.

N. Front St. runs in a general north-south direction with W. Lockhart St. intersecting from the west. N. Front St., heading southbound, is stop-controlled at the intersection.

After receiving complaints from the public, staff from the Kyle Police Department (KPD), the Public Works Department and the Engineering Department visited the subject intersection in order to observe the existing traffic flow conditions. Based on our observations, there appears to be some confusion caused by the lack of STOP signs and pavement markings.

Additionally, there appears to be a need to control left-turn conflicts. The existing parking spaces in front of the Police Department along Front St. and W. Lockhart St. and the parking spaces in front of the Kyle Library Thrift Shop add to the confusion in the intersection since there are no markings through the intersection.

Based on information provided by KPD and staff observation, it is my engineering judgment that the installation of a multi-way stop control and markings is appropriate at the intersection of N. Front St. and W. Lockhart St.
