A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE COSTS OF RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR FOR THE KYLE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM JANUARY 1, 2018 NOT TO EXCEED TWELVE MONTHS; AGREEING AND ASSURING THAT IN THE EVENT OF LOSS OR MISUSE OF SAID GRANT FUNDS, THE CITY WILL RETURN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, REJECT, ALTER OR TERMINATE THE GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THE RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND MAKING SUCH OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED HERETO.

WHEREAS, the city council finds that it in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the officers that the rifle-resistant grant be submitted on behalf of the Kyle Police Department and funded for fiscal year 2018; and,

WHEREAS, the city council finds that authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, is for the purpose of funding the costs of rifle-resistant body armor for the Kyle Police Department from January 1, 2018 not to exceed twelve months.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings. The above recitals are found to be true and correct and are adopted by the city council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Authorization of acceptance of grant. The city council authorizes the submission of said grant for the purpose of funding rifle-resistant body armor for the Kyle Police Department from January 1, 2018 not to exceed twelve months.

Section 3. Return of grant funds. The city council agrees and assures that in the event of loss or misuse of said grant funds, the total amount of funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor's Criminal Justice Division.

Section 4. Authorized official. The acting city manager or city manager is authorized to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the city council.

Section 5. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public as required by the Open Meetings Act,

Chapter 551, Local Government Code, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by said Act.

Section 6. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage as authorized by the Charter of the City of Kyle, Texas.
