A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A ONE YEAR GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,468.80 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, OFFICE OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE KYLE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S JUVENILE JUSTICE OFFICER FULL-TIME POSITION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018; AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING MATCHING FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT \$30,298.00 TO **EXCEED FROM** THE KYLE DEPARTMENT'S APPROVED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL; MAKING SUCH OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED HERETO; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the city council finds that it in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the city's residents that a juvenile justice officer full-time position be funded for Fiscal Year 2017-2018; and.

**WHEREAS**, the city council finds that authorizing the acceptance of a grant from the US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in the amount of \$42,468.80 will provide funding for a full-time juvenile justice officer position Fiscal Year 2017-2018;

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings. The above recitals are found to be true and correct and are adopted by the city council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Authorization of acceptance of grant. The city council authorizes the acceptance of the said grant for the purpose of providing funding for a full-time juvenile justice officer position for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

Section 3. Matching funds. The city council authorizes and agrees to provide matching funds in an amount not to exceed \$30,298.00 from the Kyle Police Department's approved budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018, as required by the terms and conditions of said grant project.

Section 4. Return of grant funds. The city council agrees and assures that in the event of loss or misuse of said grant funds, the total amount of funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division of the Governor's Office.

Section 5. Authorized official. The city manager is authorized to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the city council.

Section 6. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Local Government Code, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by said Act.

Section 7. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage as authorized by the Charter of the City of Kyle, Texas.
