

WHEREAS, 6.3 million Texans have experienced some form of sexual assault in their lifetime; and

WHEREAS, 2 in 5 women and 1 in 5 men in Texas have been sexually assaulted in their lifetime affecting all races, ages and economic situations; and

WHEREAS, the Hays-Caldwell Women's Center provided direct services to 651 adult victims of sexual assault in Hays and Caldwell Counties last year including 119 victims from Kyle; and

WHEREAS, Hays County is intolerant of sexual violence in any form and recognizes that education and awareness may prevent sexual assault; and

WHEREAS, efforts to reduce sexual assault can only be successful through citizen involvement, and the safety of the citizens of Hays County depends upon our actions to end sexual assault;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Travis Mitchell, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Kyle, Texas, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2018

"SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS & PREVENTION MONTH"
