A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS TO JOIN THE CENTRAL TEXAS CLEAN AIR COALITION (CAC) OF THE CAPITAL AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (CAPCOG); DIRECTING STAFF ON ASSOCIATED ITEMS; AND SELECTING A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE CAC.

WHERE AS, air pollution levels in the Austin-Round Rock Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) periodically reach levels that are considered unhealthy for sensitive groups and are close to being in violation of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS);

WHERE AS, the City of Kyle recognizes the health and environmental benefits of clean air and the economic benefits of remaining in compliance with the NAAQS;

WHERE AS, the Central Texas Clean Air Coalition (CAC) of the Capital Area Council of Governments (CAPCOG) is a voluntary association of organizations in the Austin-Round Rock MSA that develops, adopts, and implements a clean air plan to achieve and maintain compliance with federal ground-level ozone standards;

WHERE AS, the Action Plan adopted by the CAC helps keep the region in compliance of the NAAQS through voluntary implementation of measures to reduce local emissions selected by members; and

WHERE AS, becoming a general member of the CAC requires that a jurisdiction ratify the current clean air plan, commit to implementing selected emission reduction measures, report on these measures to CAPCOG; and appoint an elected official as the jurisdiction's representative to the CAC;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS,

That the City of Kyle ratifies the CAC's Ozone Advance Program Action Plan;

That the City of Kyle directs staff to implement the attached list of measures as part of the CAC's Ozone Advance Program Action Plan and report on such measures to CAPCOG;

That the City of Kyle directs staff to designate an air quality liaison to provide reports to CAPCOG and provide the City Council of the City of Kyle with periodic air quality updates;

That the City of Kyle formally requests to join the CAC as a general member; and

That the City Council of the City of Kyle hereby appoints [a Council Member or the Mayor] as a representative to the CAC in accordance with the CAC's by-laws if accepted as a general member of the CAC.
