




What I am doing

- Recruit volunteers from Troop 3377, Ship 1492, my family, and friends to volunteer their time to come out help construct the ADA Garden plots and ADA picnic benches.







Materials

- (1) 2x4x8ftboards
- (2) 2x4x10ftboards
- (2) 2x6x8ftboards
- (9) 2X6X12ftboards

Build


- (4) 2x6x72" pieces
- (2) 2x6x65.75" trapezoids
- (4) 2x6x39.25" parallelograms
- (3) 2x4x34.25" trapezoids
- (2) 2x4x32" parallelograms
- (6) 2x6x8ft boards
- 1lb 2 .5" deck screws
- (16) 3/8"x3.25" galvanized carriage bolts
- (16) 3/8" galvanized washers
- (16) 3/8" galvanized nuts





Supplies

- Gloves quantity of 5 boxes different sizes
- Dust mask quantity up to 5 boxes
- Trash bins quantity up to 2 boxes
- Large trash bags
- Measuring Tape
- Safety googles
- Water coolers
- Snacks






Time Frame

- I plan to complete the project by Fall of 2023








Tools

- Level 3/8 drill bit








Estimated Cost

- Total Costs \$7,500










All volunteer workers will wear eye protection when required. Hearing protection will be provided if we use loud power tools. First aid kit will be onsite at all times. Closed toe footwear, long sleeve shirts, and pants will be required for all volunteers. Volunteer workers need to use gloves at all times. Central Texas weather can change quickly. So I will monitor the weather daily. I will post signs and go over the symptoms of heatstroke, heat exhaustion, and frostbite. Since we are working in a wooded area, I will look at the are to see if there is poison ivy or oak. I will mark the area, so no one touches it. I will go over the SAFE Project Tool Use provided by the BSA and post on site.
