Re:	2010 Future Land Use Map amendment

Dear Commissioners:

At our last meeting in September, staff introduced both the character area designations indicated on the City's 2010 Future Land Use Map (FLUM), and the externalities that affect the assignment of those designations. We heard from the city's engineer about water and waste water availability and talked about the opportunities and constraints related to economic development of those areas of the city which aren't yet developed.

At this work session, the P&Z with the assistance of city staff should begin the earliest draft of what form the FLUM should take. The draft should take into account concepts like the availability of water, and waste water services, as well as the city's future transportation network, and the patterns of development already on the ground.

This process will ultimately prepare Kyle directly for physical development planning, such as Capital Improvement Planning and appropriate budgeting for the next decade.

There is a blank FLUM map attached as back up to this agenda item. Staff encourages the commissioners to take notes on the map and make a personal draft map to share with the entire body as we debate the policy moving forward.
